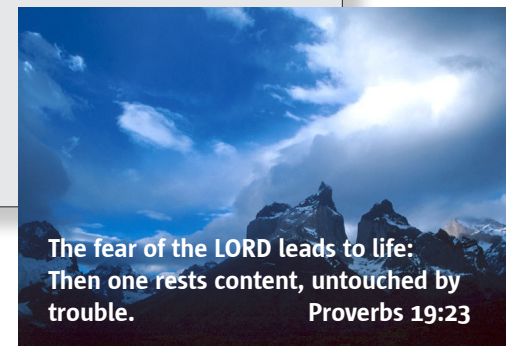

## church prayer agenda

Today we stand at the threshold of the unknown. Before us lies a new year. We are going forward to take possession of it. We don't know what awaits us there. We only know there are a lot of uncertainties which cause us to fear. But our Father has a comforting message for us all - "The Lord your God cares for (it); the eyes of the Lord is continually on it from the beginning of the year to its end" (Deut 11: 11-12)

1) Thank you Daddy for watching over the New Year which we are entering. You are the Source of supply for our every need. Your river will never run dry nor can it be cut off. Help us to rest in You, and cast out all fear of the uncertainties that may come upon Singapore in the new year.

2) In the midst of uncertainties, empower us not to hold back or draw back; consolidate or conserve the resources you have given us. Help us to keep trusting You and Your plan for our lives. Help us to magnify You; and reflect You as the mighty and powerful God that You really are.

3) In the new year, pray for exceptional courage, integrity and dedication to be an over-comer; and not to remain passive as a casualty. Through the year enable me to infect those around me with my faith; hope and love - in my word and care & concern.

4) Pray over each other (in the cell/Sunday School etc):

I bless you in the New Year to:

- Fear the Lord your God and serve Him only (Deut 6:13)

- Not follow other gods, the gods of the people around you (Deut 6:14)

- Be strong and very courageous. Be careful to obey all the law that you may be successful wherever you go (Josh 1:7)
