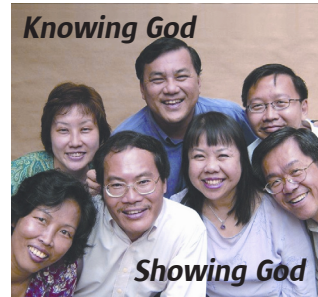
But Jacob said to him, "My lord knows that the children are tender and that I must care for the ewes and cows that are nursing their young. If they are driven hard just one day, all the animals will die. So let my lord go on ahead of his servant, while I move along slowly at the pace of the droves before me and that of the children, until I come to my lord in Seir." (Gen 33:13-14)

What a beautiful picture of Jacob's thoughtfulness for the cattle and the children! He would not allow them to be driven too hard for even one day. He would not lead them at a pace equal to what a strong man like Esau could keep or expected them to keep, but only one as fast as they were able to endure. He knew exactly how far they could go in a day, and he made that his only consideration in planning their travel. He had taken the same wilderness journey years before and knew from his personal experience its roughness, heat, and distance. And so he said "I will move along slowly." (Adapted from Streams in the Desert updated edition)

Entering into 2009, We are treading on a road we have never been before. But the Lord Jesus knows the way. He knows the way through the wilderness of our life, and He will gently guide us through it. In the past month I have on a couple of occasions cried out to God "Help! Lord, things are happening too unexpectedly and too fast. I can't cope". Each time I would stop and spend time to seek refuge in Him. Time and time again I came out refreshed and strengthened by His reassuring kindness and faithfulness. I don't know what lies ahead but I know WHO holds my every tomorrow. Beloved, take comfort in this assurance, especially to those who are fearful and weary.

"....I will be with you and will bless you. For to you and your descendants I will give all these land.....and though your offspring all nations on earth will be blessed...." (Gen 26:3-4)

We are all descendants of Abraham, and are entrusted this calling to bless all nations on earth. Let us aspire to receive every blessing which the Father has planned for us individually, so that we can first bless our Nation, and her people in this very trying time, both materially and spiritually.

1. Do not be bashful. Affirm the Lord's intention to bless you in all ways. Ask for a touch of greatness and abundance in His plan, which He only can give. Ask God to enlarge your territory and area of influence wherever you are placed. Ask God for more opportunities to be a channel of blessing to our Nation and our people.

2. As Joseph distributed bread to the nations during his time, ask God to give us in abundance, both physical and spiritual bread to feed the multitudes in our city.
