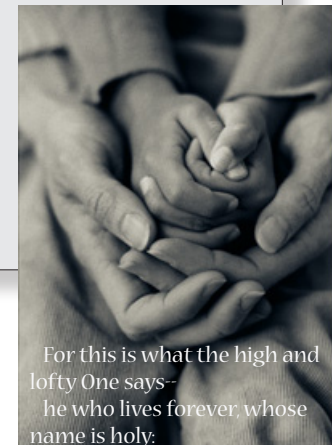

A bright ASEAN Scholar, David Widjaja's performance was slipping and he was struggling with his final year project. But what made him lose his mind, act this way, and give up his life?

My only answer was that he had lost hope. Hope which lay in his making the Engineering Honour's roll. He could not see life beyond and possibly held his professor as the hindrance responsible.

Hope sustains a man in adversity. When ultimate hope is set on an achievement, a status, a property, a relationship, or good health, its loss pushes a man off the edge. Without hope, purpose is lost. He resorts to unthinkable measures; one such as Widjaja's.

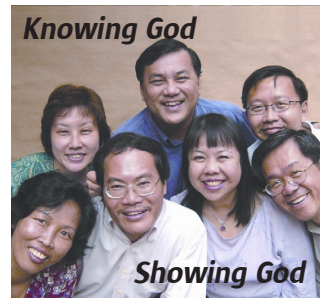

The current growing global financial crisis is affecting every nation on earth. Survival of many companies in Singapore is being threatened like never before. Losses of jobs & homes; losses of security and income of fami-

lies loom large in everyone's mind. There's no telling when this will end.

It's time for KY and all churches to play our part to bring about God's protection and solution into this situation. It's a call for all intercessors to take up their place at this moment in history, to bring this matter before God for His wisdom and solution to prevail.

1) Declare with conviction that: *"We are in the world, but not of the world. We are not governed by the world's economy but by God's economy. Jehovah Jireh is our Provider. He will never fail us nor forsake us. This global meltdown is not something that has caught Daddy by surprise. In fact He allows it. Daddy has a plan to see me and His children come through these difficult times just as He has done before. I will come through it and be stronger, together with my brothers & sisters in KY family."*

2) Lift up our Nation's leaders before God. Ask God for His sovereign hand to be with them and guide them in their meetings on this crisis. Bless them with revelation and understanding to see beyond the obvious. Release to them a heart of wisdom and clear thinking to mete out steps to lessen the severity of this crisis on our Nation, and guide them to bring Singapore back to calm waters.
