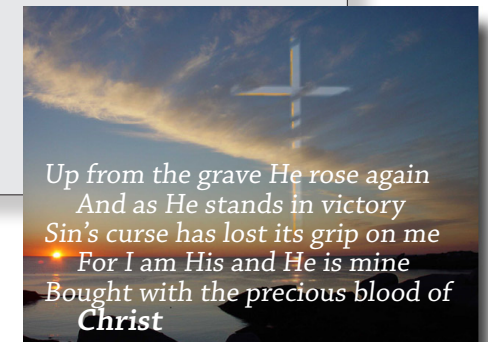

## from the pastor's heart

We remember the resurrection of Christ on this Easter Sunday. It is a historical event which happened in the history of time. The Bible does not give a detailed account of how the resurrection of Christ took place but it uses the testimonies of many eyewitnesses to attest to this fact. An important concept is the "Resurrected Christ" which speaks of a fully living Christ, one who has risen from the dead; not just an event in history but an experience of saving faith for all who believe. This gives rise to an incomparable power for those who trust in the Lord.

The Bible records that when Jesus' beloved disciple ran to the tomb and saw the strips of linen lying there (John 20:3-8), he saw and believed even though the Resurrected Christ had not yet appeared to him. He remembered all that Jesus had taught and foretold, Jesus' mission, and knew without a doubt that things would not just stop at the strips of linen but that something extraordinary and amazing would happen.

Thus we know that one does not need to see the Resurrected Christ with the natural eye in order to believe, rather the Holy Spirit will help us to experience the Resurrected Christ when we hear God speak and through the witness of the Church and believers.

Down through the ages and generations, the Resurrected Christ has become the core of the faith of the Church. When Jesus was nailed to the Cross, his disciples were filled with fear and despair; but after they experienced the Resurrected Christ they were totally transformed. Therefore the Resurrected Christ is not just a message because the Lord Jesus through his victory over death has brought us a new attitude, a new value system and a new power for life.

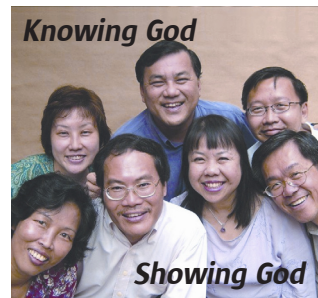
May we help the people around us to also

## church prayer agenda

We hear of news that the recession has reached bottom, and recovery may come end of this year. Whilst we hope this is true – we are also told that the present situation may become worse before it becomes better. But regardless of what comes in the midst of continuing turmoil and job uncertainty, let's keep holding tight in our trust in God who is in full control. The storm may show its threatening snarls, but let's focus our spiritual eyes on the Lord behind the storm – standing mighty and strong, waiting to deliver us at the moment of His choosing. He is never too late.

1) Some of us are burdened by unpaid bills and discouragement resulting from the current crisis. Ask God to give them courage to tackle the problems they face. Give them wisdom in taking decisions which will turn their situation around. Ask God to deliver them from their distress and restore order and normalcy to their lives as they cry out to Him.

2) Ask God to show special mercy to those among us who are retrenched. Empower them to get over with the disappointment and bitterness of losing a job. Help them not to lose hope in God. Ask God to open ways for them to be re-employed quickly, even in the midst of critical times. God is able.

3) As the crisis deepens, more may suffer the setback of retrenchment. Ask God to remove from KY people the negative stigma of unemployment, retrenchment and financial difficulties. Instead create in KY an environment in which members who are affected feel free to openly discuss their problems and be prayed for. Ask God to help KY people become more aware of the needs of people affected by this crisis and readily show care and concern, and share their resources with them.
