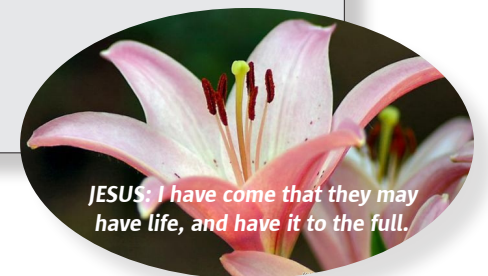

Matthew 19:13-15 recorded that 'Then little children were brought to Jesus for him to place his hands on them and pray for them. But the disciples rebuked those who brought them. 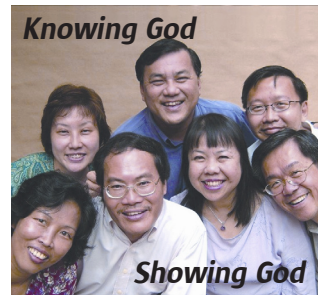

Missions is the central responsibility of the Church of God. God has led KY to take on this responsibility in a bigger way this year. About 80 have signed up to go for short term missions to China where KY has established missions work. This list is still growing. KY is enlarging her tent in the nations. As we attempt great things for God, we expect, and we will see, great things from God.

1. Pray for a mighty outpouring of the Holy Spirit to stir the hearts of KY people to obey by carrying out the Great Commission in this end-times. Ask God to continue to enlarge KY's missions vision. Keep us in step with the Spirit's leading to unleash KY people to be part of the harvest-force to the Chinese people, redeeming them to become followers and worshippers of the only true God of the Universe.

2. Pray that KY people will be His bridge of blessing and hope, especially to the marginalized, the forgotten people, the poor and needy whom we meet in the field. Let compassion and tenderness arise from our hearts as a channel for the power the Holy Spirit to flow out from us toward them.

3. In Jesus' name - let us renounce the fear of language learning, and the actual using of the Chinese language which we are not fluent in, while with the people. Declare: "with God all things are possible". Ask God to bless KY people with a supernatural capacity to acquire fluency in the language of the people He calls us to serve.

4. As KY minister to the people there - ask God to empower us to minister in power to "Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers; raise the dead; and cast out demons" just as He promised. (Matt 10:7-8)
