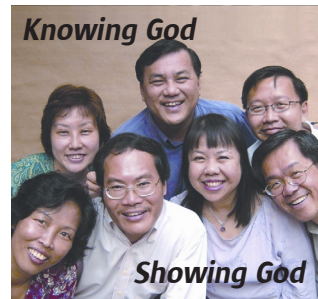
Not only that we can serve God without fear, **we can also serve in holiness and righteousness** by the promised transforming grace of God and power of the Holy Spirit. Hallelujah!

“...all peoples on earth will be blessed through you.” (Gen 12:3)

“...and through your offspring all nations on earth will be blessed” (Gen 26:4)

It is always God's will to bless mankind.

He has planned to bless mankind through Abraham and his descendants. The baton has now been passed on to us as Abraham's descendants to bless the people around us; particularly so in a crisis situation like now. His blessings cannot be thwarted by the crisis.

1) Ask God to empower us to follow His commands and be obedient to follow all His ways, especially during the current financial crisis.
