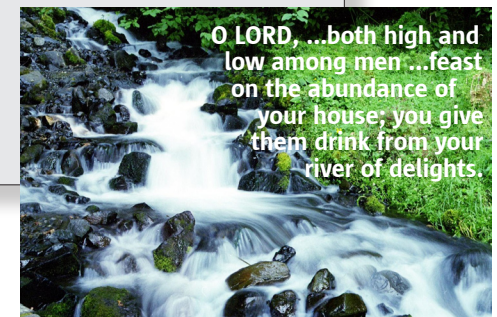

As this virus is highly contagious and with the density of global traffic, it was quickly spread across countries by the ever-increasing numbers of infected persons.

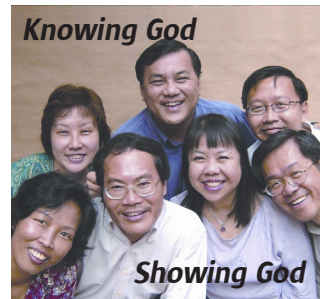
Although Singapore had her first confirmed case two weeks ago, very soon more appeared one after another. There wasn't any of the fear and panic of the early stage because our government had prepared the public with proper instruction and procedure to handle any infection in a responsible manner. It had stayed on a high level of alert to prevent any spread of the virus in the community. These preventative measures ensured that infections in our locale remain under control, slowing down its spread. The crux of the matter is about taking prevention and precaution seriously.

Applying this preventative measure against viral infections to the life of a believer results in a similar principle and efficacy. The Apostle Peter in 1 Peter 8:8-10 said "Be self-controlled and alert. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour. Resist him, standing firm in the faith, ... after you have suffered a little while, will himself restore you and make you strong, firm and steadfast." Peter reminded the believers to be self-controlled and alert in order to ward off the devil who comes to attack them at any time or place. We can easily be overcome by sin if our hearts are not on guard and sensitively alert to the devastating power of sin. Meet each day with an alert heart, by the truth of God's Word and by prayer stand your ground against the devil's attack. May the Holy Spirit enable us to live victorious lives with steadfast faith.

The month of June - August will see the inaugural KY-organized adult missions outreach teams in action. Over 70 members from different congregations divided into 6 teams will be going to different parts of China for short term missions. All who are not going this time are asked to be involved by praying for them.

1) Ask God to open our eyes to see God's heart for the harvest. Stir our hearts to respond in serving God in the harvest. Enlarge KY's missions territory with each passing year.

2) Pray for our short-term Missioners:

- Ask God to put in their heart a passion for Jesus that will translate into a constraining love which propels them to draw near, and reach out to the people whom God directs them to meet.

- Anoint their lips to release words of blessing and kindness each time they speak. Let their tongues speak forth God's Word that sustain and restore the weary. Let their mouths boldly declare the Truth of God's healing & power over the sick, helpless and hopeless ones while in the field.

- Ask God for a spirit of submission and obedience in every missioner toward their team leader. Let the spirit of love, unity and harmony continue to prevail in everyone while in the mission field.
