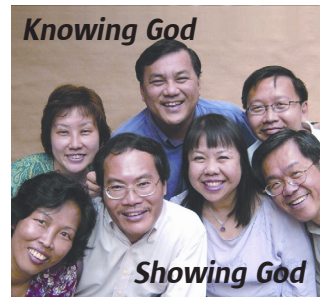

"...you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people belonging to God..." (1 Pet 2:9). God considers us as worthy to be counted amongst kings and priests. He places us in the privileged position to be part of His royal family to testify of His goodness. We ought to conduct ourselves like royalties before God and man.

1. As a people separated unto God, earnestly ask God to stir our hearts to desire to bear in greater measure the fruit of the Spirit in our life – love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, faithfulness, gentleness, goodness and self control.
2. Pray for the spirit of discernment to come against conforming to the patterns and things of this world which will lead us into worldliness and away from God. Help us to form the discipline to daily draw near to God.
3. Acknowledge that we belong to God; to live for Him, to glorify Him. Ask God to help us daily be on guard against the sinful desires which war against us to destroy us. Help us to put to death whatever belongs to our earthly nature (Col 3:5) and to walk in holiness before God.
