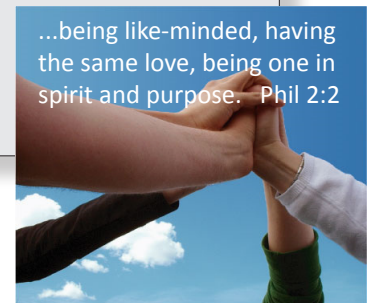

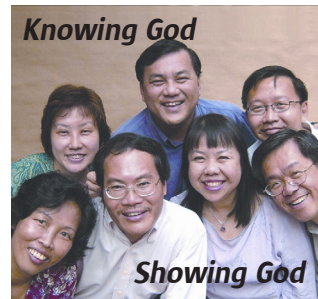

## church prayer agenda

Thank God! 3 teams have gone to, and returned from China for short-term missions. Every team has returned with stories about how God has used each team to be a channel of blessing; and how the team members have been blessed themselves. 3 other teams are all set to go in August. KY is truly enlarging her tent in missions to the nations, especially China. But more can be done. For to whom much is given, much is required.

1) Ask God to further enlarge KY's missions vision. Keep us in step with the Holy Spirit; and in tune with God's timing. Stir KY people to respond to the missions call to the neediest nations, especially China, in unprecedented numbers. Activate all to pray for, and to give to missions.

2) Ask God to empower the 3 teams that are going to China for short-term trips in August. Wherever they go in the name of Jesus:-

- They will drive out demons and bring down strongholds
- They will speak the Word with power and authority
- They will lay hands on the sick and they shall recover
