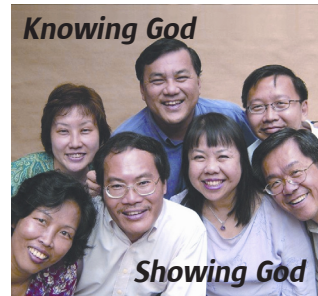
May God give us grace and mercy to continue
