Presently for the weekly devotions of the staff team we are looking at the lesson of "honour". Personally I feel that we need to first learn the lesson of humility if we want to respect the authority above us and the people around us. Humility is a difficult lesson to master, not only is it step by step but it is also a lifelong learning. "Young men, in the same way be submissive to those who are older. All of you, clothe yourselves with humility toward one another, because, "God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble."" (1 Peter 5:5) If we are at odds with someone, we must be humble and take the initiative to reconcile with him.

Not only must we learn to be humble, we must also be able to submit to one another. Humility is an expression of how we live, while submission is the action borne out of that attitude. When we are humble we can see others as better than ourselves, yet at the same time know that God values us. Submission is to willingly put ourselves under another's authority. If there is disagreement, we must learn to submit to authority as long as the truth is upheld. Saint Augustine said: "It was pride that changed angels into devils; it is humility that makes men as angels." Pride led to the fall of the angels and this is our best warning and wake-up call. Hence we must be humble in order to be blessed for Jesus said: "Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. (Matthew 5:3) Recently when our church leaders met with the CAC President to discuss the appointment of our new pastor-in-charge, may we as a church be whole-heartedly united in prayer that God's guidance for us is the best. May we learn the lesson of humility in receiving our new pastor-in-charge and submitting to the assignment of the CAC.

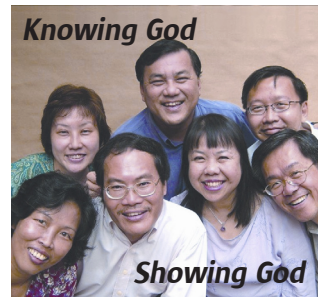

At the 'Day of His Power' grand prayer meeting on August 7 2009 - the call to prevailing corporate intercessory prayer by the churches during the next 5 years leading to Singapore's Jubilee in 2015 was flashed on the screen at

the start of the Service.

We believe that such intercessory prayers done in unity and harmony is powerful and earth-shaking. It brings about national revival; to heal our land and unleash supernatural signs and wonders into His Church. Corporate intercessory prayer is an integral and important part of KY for which every KY people is asked to be involved actively.

1. In the years leading to Singapore's Jubilee in 2015, let's corporately ask the Lord to move mightily in extraordinary miracles through ordinary believers in KY, and in all Singapore churches. Let miraculous signs and wonders become a daily phenomenon in the churches, triggering dramatic outcomes in people coming in droves to embrace Jesus as Lord like it happened in the early church.
