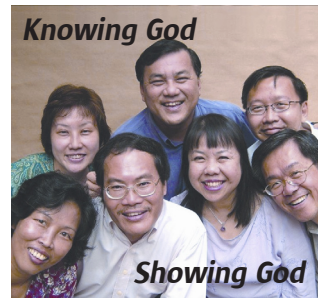
In the Bible we read of Hannah's sorrow because she was barren; although her husband Elkanah reassured her of his love time and again, Hannah could not be comforted. She refused to eat. But interestingly, after Hannah had poured out her heart and soul to the LORD in prayer, the first thing she did was to eat something. In this Hannah has given us another picture of prayer - that after pouring out her heart and soul to God, she knew how to let the matter go. To Hannah praying was not a means to force God into action but it was about being a daughter who expresses her desire to her father, fully trusting that he will listen to her heartfelt outpouring. This time after her conversation with the Heavenly Father, Hannah was no more downcast and ate normally.

After we pour out our heart and soul to God may we learn to let go and refuse to cling on to sorrow or dissatisfaction. May we learn to trust the guidance of a loving God, a God who never gives up on us even though we are rebellious. Though things may not be as we hope for, we can move on because God is ever the loving Heavenly Father from beginning to end.

At the 'Day of His Power' grand prayer meeting on August 7 2009 - the call to prevailing corporate intercessory prayer by the churches during the next 5 years leading to Singapore's

Jubilee in 2015 was flashed on the screen at the start of the Service.

We believe that such intercessory prayers done in unity and harmony is powerful and earth-shaking. It brings about national revival; to heal our land and unleash supernatural signs and wonders into His Church. Corporate intercessory prayer is an integral and important part of KY for which every KY people is asked to be involved actively.

1. In the years leading to Singapore's Jubilee in 2015, let's corporately ask the Lord to move mightily in extraordinary miracles through ordinary believers in KY, and in all Singapore churches. Let miraculous signs and wonders become a daily phenomenon in the churches, triggering dramatic outcomes in people coming in droves to embrace Jesus as Lord like it happened in the early church.

2. Ask God to pour out His Spirit of prayer upon KY; to transform KY into God's Powerhouse of Prayer :-

- where Christians march on their knees in persevering prayer together;
- where corporate prayers are held in unity, harmony and in great numbers;
- where God is pleased to dwell, to command blessings to the nations, just like He promised when King Solomon dedicated the temple to Him.

3. Pray Jeremiah 33:6 & 9 for our Nation until Jubilee

"God, YOU will bring health and healing to Singapore,
YOU will heal Your people and will let them enjoy abundant peace & security;
Then this City will bring YOU renown, joy, praise and honor before all nations on earth that hear of all the good things YOU do for her,
And they will be in awe and will tremble at the abundance of prosperity and peace YOU provide for her."
