from the pastor's heart

Are you listening to the Word of God or listening to the God of the Word?

Christians hold the word of God with the highest regard. And rightly so! But as we engage the word of God, it is important to be mindful that the word must lead us to God. It is possible to read or listen to God's word or a sermon but miss God altogether.

How, one may ask?

First, listening with the head but not connecting with the heart. There is a place for the debate and sparring over the word of God. But if it does not lead to a heart change nothing much happens. The truth of God must be allowed to journey from the head to the heart and take root there. A bible study should end in an examination of our own condition, acknowledgment of our shortcomings, and the need for change. Often resulting in the compulsion to kneel before the Lord in confession and asking for help for transformation.

Second, listening for somebody else. How often do we think to ourselves, 'Ha! This message is just right for so and so'. Or 'I wish so and so was here to listen to this, he needs to hear this'. Listening to the word must primarily be for ourselves - God and me. What is God saying to me? What is He addressing in my life?

Third, listening to teach. This again by-passes the heart. Remember that we can only truly teach the word when our lives are regularly broken by the word. The best teachers are those who have allowed the word to master them instead of just trying to master the word.

Fruitful hearing is primarily for personal heart change, not for somebody else or mastering

knowledge to teach others. Allow the word of God to go through you and wash you. By this be transformed and conformed to the image of Christ. The measure of whether one has truly listened to God's word is by the fruit of the Spirit one bears over time.

A very eventful 2009 is drawing to an end - a year in which we are able to go through only under the canopy of God's guidance and protection. With Singapore officially out of the global recession, we will refocus our attention to continue to build KY to be the church which grows in numbers as well as in spiritual power; in charisma as well as in character - like the early church which Jesus Christ built.

1. Throughout Acts, almost all the supernatural events which happened took place as a result of corporate prayers. Ask God to bring about the revival of passionate, corporate prayers in KY which engage the maximum number of KY people devoting themselves to steadfast prayer in the same mind; and in full agreement.
