Nurturing Families, Growing Believers

Deuteronomy 6: 4-9

Today marks the Chinese Annual Conference (CAC) Family Sunday of the Methodist Church in Singapore, a special occasion dedicated to reaffirming the significance of the bond between believers and their families. A strong family serves as the cornerstone of a vibrant church and a flourishing nation. Indeed, the family is the nurturing cradle of human life and growth, an indispensable foundation of both the church and society. Throughout the Bible, we find teachings and reminders emphasizing the vital role of family education and the cultivation of sound values.

Deuteronomy 6 recounts Moses' reiteration of God's commandments to the Israelites in the plains of Moab, just before their entry into the Promised Land of Canaan. He fervently stressed the imperative of obeying God's commandments to receive His abundant blessings.

Verses 4-9 highlight for believers the importance of spiritual growth and the worship of God in one's family. First and foremost, we called to listen to God, worshipping the one and only Almighty, and to love Him with unwavering devotion. Secondly, we are commanded to embed God's teachings deep within our hearts, reflecting upon them ceaselessly, proclaiming them, and diligently passing them on to our children, ensuring their transmission to future generations. May God's Words permeate our hearts, our homes, and every facet of our lives — let us inscribe them on our hearts and on the doorframes of our households, regarding God's Word as the bedrock of our personal lives and family relationships.

The book of Genesis reveals that the family is the first institution established by God, it also illustrates God's profound interest in the creation and management of family life. For instance, the Scripture "*... a man leaves his father and mother and is united to his wife,*

and they become one flesh.", stands as a cornerstone teaching on spousal relationship. Genesis further explores the relationships between parents and children, as well as between siblings. In essence, believers are entrusted with nurturing all relationships with care, fostering a harmonious, stable, and blessed family environment.

Crucially, the family is neither parent-centered nor child-centered but rather God-centered. "Write on the doorframe" symbolizes a family rooted in reverence and devotion to God. The family is also a place where individual character is molded. A God-centered family embodies love, warmth, and health — spouses cherish one another, children honour their parents, and all members foster mutual respect and intimacy, guided by wholesome family and marital values, and blessed by God across generations.

As the foundational unit established by God, the family bears the weighty responsibility of fulfilling His commandment to govern the world. Indeed, it is through the family that we are called to be "*fruitful and increase in number; fill the earth and subdue it.*" Beyond imparting God's truths, the church also serves as the spiritual home for believers. "Family Sunday" provides an opportune moment for believers to impart and uphold the concept of family grounded in biblical principles. A God-centered family, guided by His Word, embodying and living out the teachings of the Bible on family life, and loving God with unreserved fervour, is assuredly bound for divine blessing!

Ask God to strengthen Kum Yan Church that we remain a lighthouse in the city. Pray that our worship, fellowship, teaching, ministry, and missions are built upon God's truths and commandments. May our congregations grow spiritually, and our church experience revival, exalting Jesus Christ and glorifying the name of the Lord!

CAC Family Life Pledge

The Christian Family

is the visible pattern to the Body of Christ; the head of every man is Christ, the head of a wife is her husband, and the head of Christ is God. Children are to follow the example of Christ-like love set by their parents, and every member of the family is to love and submit to one another out of reverence for Christ. Families are to come together as one to interact with, serve and nurture one another in love, through family worship and prayer, so that as a family, they may bear witness to Christ from generation to generation.

CHURCH PLANTING TEAM RECRUITMENT

The LCEC has approved the proposal from the Mission Committee to send forth a Church Planting (CP) team to **Nagoya, Japan in June 2025**.

WHO & WHAT?

We are recruiting a team of 4 to 6 individuals (preferably aged 35 and below) to be based in Japan for 10 months, focusing on relationship building, conducting outreach programs and establishing a local cell group for the Japanese.

The aim of the team will be to share the gospel and make disciples for Christ, with an end goal of planting a church there. They will also work closely with the local churches and community leaders to ensure the success and sustainability of this endeavour.

SCREENING & TRAINING

Interested parties will be screened for selection. Successful candidates will go through two phases of training/ preparation:

- 12 months of language acquisition to attain N5 Japanese proficiency
- 2 months of in-house communal comprehensive training in Singapore, focusing on cultural immersion, team dynamics and CP strategies in a cross-cultural context.


